Please have your child arrive on time as we will be leaving the building shortly after 9:15. The parking restriction will be lifted on George St. so we remind you that there will be no parking in the lot. All Children will be dismissed after the refreshments with their families.

Reminders

*Traffic -Please turn off your car while waiting for the doors to open in the morning and for children to be dismissed. The church has a strict no idling policy that helps ensure the health of others waiting outside. We also ask that you do not park in the lot to walk your child to the door. We have very limited spaces & if there are any spaces available, they are for parents who are staying for the day. Please pass this on to whoever drops off your child!!

*Please help us keep germs to a minimum. Please teach your child to cover his/her nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing. Children should also know how to use a tissue and blow their nose. Please keep children home when they are feverish and/or coughing, sneezing consistently.
